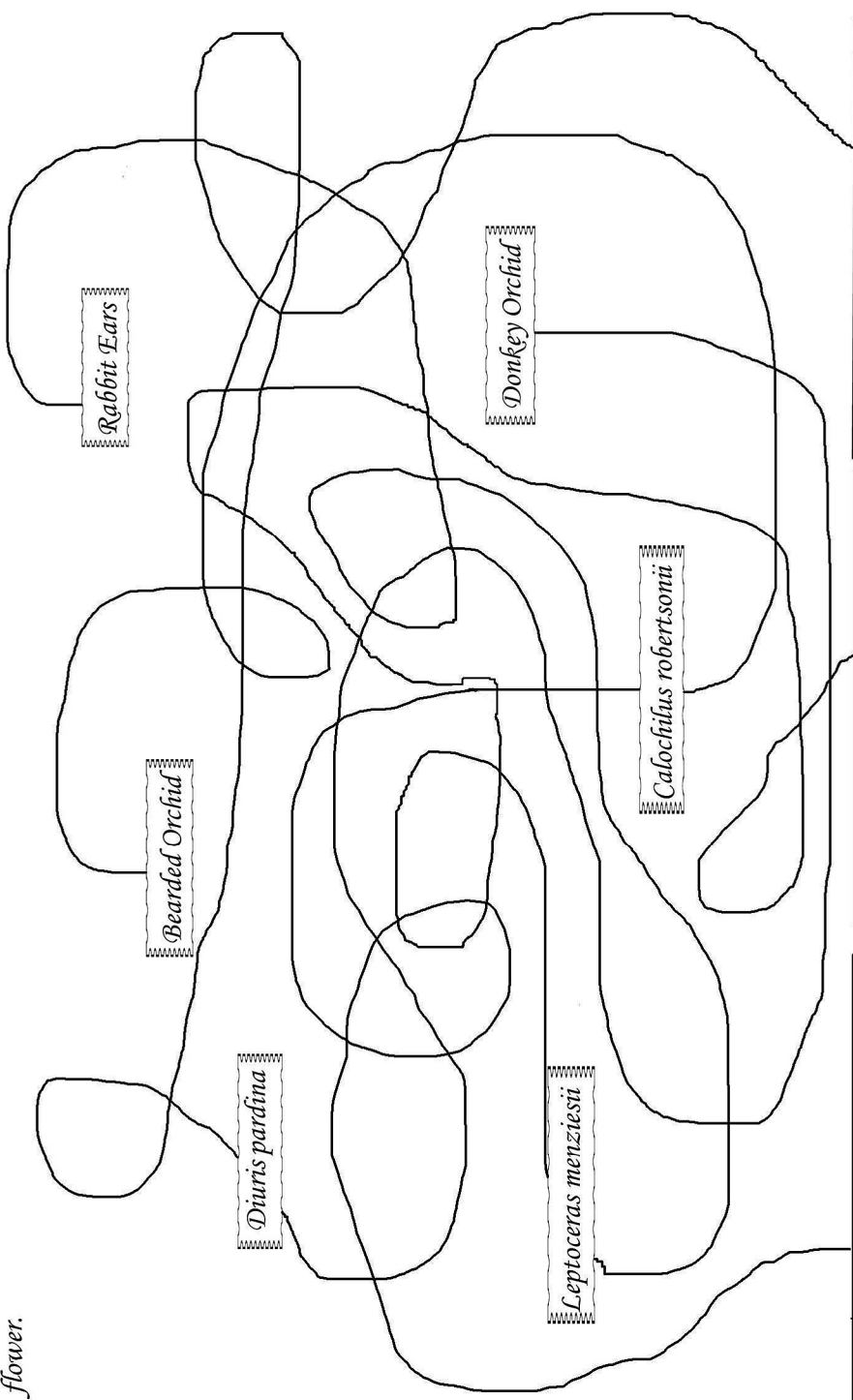




MATCH THE FLOWERS WITH THEIR NAMES


